### **Job Description for the role of Mukhyaji**

The applicant will have to be a qualified Mukhyaji within prescribed Pushti Marg rituals and practices.

- To be taught and trained in India by a descendant of Vallabhacharya Mahaprabhuji so as to adequately perform the Seva of Shree Krishna during the seven Darshans.
- To complete and carry out daily religious activities and responsibility of the Haveli.
- To be required to carry out the requisite religious service by performing the daily rituals for the Deity of waking him, dressing, offering food and putting him to sleep.
- To perform the daily routine to enable worshipers to have daily Darshan.

### **Job Duties and role**

- The applicant is to lead daily worships and carry out special preparations for the important occasions by the Hindu calendar.
- To provide religious education for children and adults by preaching or teaching.
